

# Marching Band Tour 2025 San Juan, El Yunque, Icacos Cay, Ponce April 14 - 19



The members of the Council Rock South Marching Band will have the opportunity to visit Puerto Rico, the "Shining Star of the Caribbean." We will explore the rich history and culture, exceptional food, pristine beaches, and majestic mountains, all in a sun-drenched Caribbean paradise. Puerto Rico is full of welcoming people and "buena gente" (which in Boricua slang means kind and friendly). Here you will feel like you are part of the family instead of just a visitor. Around every corner you will find a celebration of life, a vibrant cultural experience, tasty food and a captivating rhythm.

Our students will be immersed in the sights and sounds of San Juan, famous for its tropical beaches, historic sites, art museums, salsa music, and the picturesque Museums. The band will embark on a walking tour of the city including stops at La Muralla, La Fortaleza and Museo de Casa Blanca. We will visit El Morro Castle and the San Juan Botanical Gardens. The band members and their families will visit El Yunque, the only tropical forest within the U.S. National Forest Service. We'll Enjoy snorkeling, swimming, and sunbathing on the beautiful island of Icacos Cay. Our Band Family will also enjoy a trip to Ponce where we will see the Castillo Serrallés and la Plaza Las Delicias.

Our five nights will be spent in picturesque Buyamon, a suburb of San Juan located in the northern coastal valley.

The Marching Band, Concert Band and Color Guard will have performance opportunities at the <u>Puerto</u> <u>Rico Conservatory of Music</u>, and an exchange performance opportunity with the <u>Banda Escolar de</u> <u>Guayanilla</u>. All repertoire and venues will be released at a later date.

Chaperone duties will be provided by the Council Rock South marching band staff, and administrators. The tour package is being provided by Music Festivals and Tours.

## <u>Cost</u>

## Approximately \$2,800 per student

The price could fluctuate up or down based on the following factors: The number of students and family members attending (the higher the number, the lower the cost), transport of equipment (airline surcharge), and airport taxes and fuel surcharges – these are not under our control. We have done our best to anticipate all surcharges 12 months away from the trip.

#### MONDAY, APRIL 14

#### **Depart for Puerto Rico**

**Morning:** Depart Council Rock South High School for Philadelphia or Newark International Airport for your flight to San Juan. Upon arrival in Puerto Rico, we will meet your English Speaking Guides and enjoy an introduction to San Juan. Depending on our time of arrival, we might make our first stop at one of San Juan's popular pedestrian/shopping areas where everyone can purchase lunch on their own. Then our guides will show us some of San Juan's popular attractions including La Muralla, La Fortaleza and Museo de Casa Blanca.

#### **Hyatt Hotel Bayamon**

We'll then transfer to our hotel with an included dinner this evening (D).

#### TUESDAY, APRIL 15 San Juan Guided Tour/Performance

**Morning:** Breakfast at the hotel. Load our chartered motor coaches and transfer to **Old San Juan** where we'll enjoy a guided walking tour of this historic city. A local guide introduces you to San Juan and its 400 years of Spanish Colonial history. See the Capitol building, plazas, and museums. Enter **El Morro Castle**, a striking military fortification. We'll visit

Plaza Las Americas where there will be time to purchase lunch on your own. Later we'll visit the **San Juan Botanical Gardens**. Get an exciting look at the environment of Puerto Rico while you explore 289 acres of gardens, including a bamboo canopy, countless tropical plants, an orchid exhibit, and 125 species of palm trees. Frequented by over 60 species of birds, this visit is a real education in ecological diversity.

Afternoon: Return to the hotel where we'll have a group dinner prior to departing for the *Puerto Rico Conservatory of Music*. This is a public learning institution that offers undergraduate and graduate programs dedicated to developing musicians. The

Conservatory has been providing the local community, especially the island's youth, with the opportunity to learn and perfect their musical skills. The Conservatory serves as one of the most important academic and cultural institutions in the Caribbean and all of Latin America.

**Evening:** The *Council Rock South High School Band* will present a performance here at the Conservatory this evening. (B,D)

#### WEDNESDAY, APRIL 16 El Yunque National Forest/Catamaran Tour

**Morning:** Breakfast at the hotel. This morning we'll visit **El Yunque Caribbean National Forest**. Surrounded by millennium-old trees, catching the barest glimpse of the bright feathers of the Puerto Rican parrot and listening to the distinctive chanting of the coquí frogs (said to stop singing if ever taken away from the island), you'll understand why native Puerto Ricans considered this forest the home of the god of happiness. El Yunque is the only tropical forest within the U.S. National Forest Service and is a fantastic place to experience all the animal and plant riches that a rainforest has to offer. Time will be available to purchase lunch on your own.

Afternoon: Return to the hotel and prepare to depart for our performance exchange with the **Banda Escolar de Guayanilla**. This band has performed extensively throughout the United States over the years, most recently as a participant in the Tournament of Roses Parade a few years ago. We'll enjoy the time to meet with the members, perform and share a dinner together. (B,D)

## THURSDAY, APRIL 17

**Morning**: Breakfast at the hotel. This morning we'll load our motorcoaches and transfer to the town of Fajardo, about a 45-minute drive from San Juan. Here we'll board our private snorkeling boat for a full day excursion to **Cayo Icacos (Icacos Cay)**. Enjoy snorkeling, swimming and sunbathing on this beautiful island.

**3:00 pm**: We'll return and head back to the hotel where we'll enjoy a group dinner. (B,D)

## FRIDAY, APRIL 18 Ponce

**Morning**: Breakfast at the hotel. Today we'll enjoy a trip to **Ponce.** Our first visit will be to **Castillo Serrallés or Serralles Castle** which is one of the top attractions in Ponce. Dating back to 1930, this is a mansion that occupies a well-maintained estate of 2.5 acres, overlooking the city of Ponce. The mansion today serves as a museum and is listed in the US National Register of Historic Places. The mansion has been refurbished to make it look as it appeared in the 1930s. Touring the museum will give you insight into the sugar cane and rum industries, and their impact on the economy of Puerto Rico. There are four floors in the museum, and every floor showcases a different aspect.

Afternoon: We'll visit the popular pedestrian area in Ponce, Plaza Las Delicias, where you'll have time to purchase

lunch on your own and do some shopping. This afternoon we'll visit the **Parque De Bombas** (**Old Fire Station**), which is a former Firehouse that houses a museum honoring Ponce's firefighters' bravery and legacy. Spanish Army Lieutenant Colonel Maxino Mena designed the wooden structure for the 1882 Exhibition Trade Fair. In 1885 the city made the building Ponce's Official Firehouse. The place served as a Fire Station for over a hundred years. After closing Parque de Bombas in 1990, the city turned the building into a museum. Parque de Bombas is one of the most emblematic structures in Ponce, if not in all of Puerto Rico. They painted the building with bright red and jet-black lines, the official colors of the town of Ponce.

Evening: We'll return to our hotel with a group dinner provided. (B,D)

## SATURDAY, APRIL 19 Departure

Morning Breakfast at the hotel followed by check-out and transfer to the San Juan International Airport for our flight home. (B)

#### Things to consider for a trip to Puerto Rico:

- Sunscreen and insect repellent
